- 3) MPO staff recommends that the MPO support the Commonwealth's CY 2020 targets for these federally required measures.






Status of Boston Region MPO PBPP






Performance Target Setting Outlook

Federally Required Performance Measure Groups	MPO Update Approach	Schedule
Roadway Safety	Update annually	January 2020
Transit Asset Management	Revisit annually when updating TIP	January or February 2020
Transit Safety	Revisit annually when updating TIP	Fall/Winter 2020
 NHS Bridge and Pavement Condition NHS Reliability Interstate Truck Travel Time Reliability 	Update every four years, or when state DOT updates its four-year targets	TBD
CMAQ Traffic Congestion Targets	Update every two years, in coordination with other parties in the Boston UZA	TBD
CMAQ Emissions Reduction Targets	Update every two years, depending on federal applicability determination	TBD








Fatalities: Five-Year Averages




Fatality Rates: Five-Year Averages



Serious Injuries




Serious Injury Rates

Nonmotorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries



MPO Target Setting Options

Staff recommendation for CY 2020 targets

Support a Statewide Target

- No quantifiable target needed for the MPO area
- Agree to plan and program projects to help reach statewide target
- Work with MassDOT on target narratives for LRTP and TIP

Set a Separate Target for the MPO Area

- Commit to a quantifiable target for the MPO area
- Coordinate with MassDOT on target development
- Report targets to MassDOT, and in LRTP and TIP

FHWA reviews both state and MPO progress toward targets, but in different ways.

Upcoming Activities

Next steps:

 MPO staff to incorporate adopted targets into FFYs 2021–25 TIP, and describe how the target relates to selected projects

Future Steps:

- Review FHWA assessment of progress against 2018 targets
- Explore other MPO monitoring and target setting opportunities. For example:
 - Longer term targets (beyond one year)
 - Targets focused on specific roadway safety topic areas or issues
