

- To monitor the origin of the trips to MBTA park-and-ride lots.





Data Collection Methodology

- Dates: Tuesday,
 Wednesdays, Thursdays or
 Fridays in the spring or fall of 2017–18
- Time: After last inbound peak-period vehicle leaves station
- Locations: Surveyed lots at/near 152 MBTA stations
- Frequency: One sample day per station





Park-and-Ride Lot Capacity and Utilization



Data Dashboard

- Automobile parking for 152 MBTA stations
- Bicycle parking for every MBTA station
- Station amenities, including bicycle and pedestrian connections
- Parking utilization based on a oneday sample (2017–18 timeframe)
- Data is available for download


