What are the proposed changes?

Equity

- ✓ Align MPO measures of equity with Federal guidance
- ✓ eliminate minimum population requirement

Safety

- ✓ Align MPO measures of safety with the Commonwealth's average crash rates
- ✓ Create meaningful way to understand an area of above-average safety concern for the region



What are the results?

- Repeatable methodology with clearly defined data needs and sources
- Clear and Transparent process
- Minor change in some project scores
